- "Lumpy" shape
- Tough texture



- Oval shape
- Shiny surface



- Triangular shape
- Serrated edges



### Alder

- Round shape
- Rough surface
- Tough texture
- No point at tip



#### Hazel

- Round shape
- "Furry" surface
- Rounded shape
- Pointed tip



Willow

- Oval shape
- Slightly pointed tip
- No thorns

- Oval shape
- Slightly pointed tip

Thorny stem



### Hawthorn

- "Lobed" shape
- 3-pronged tip
- Thorny stem



## Cherry

- Round or oval shape
- Serrated edge
- Pointed tip



### lvy

- Glossy surface
- Tough texture
- 3-lobed shape



## Holly

- Dark, glossy surface
- Tough texture
- Some are spikier than others!



Sycamore

- Large
- Red stem
- 5-lobed shape
